Maplewood Creek Park is home to an array of native wildlife species. Great Blue Herons, spawning Chum Salmon, Wood Ducks, and Eagles have all been seen within this riparian habitat. The goal of our restoration initiative is to minimize invasive species, increase habitat vitality, and add new food sources for our native wildlife.

Location: Meet outside the gate on the frontage road leading into the park at the corner of Mt. Seymour Parkway and Riverside Drive.
