Our guest speakers for the evening will be the Seymour Salmonid Society. Remember that horrible rockslide back in 2014 that jammed up the river and rendered the Twin Bridge unsafe? Those rocks and debris didn't just impact those of us who loved to use the bridge and trails on the other side of the river; it severely impacted the natural migration of many species, including salmon! Losing salmon in our Seymour River would have a long term and far reaching negative impact; the river itself supports as a resource for everyone living in BC. The society is responsible for taking the lead on managing and fundraising for the rockslide mitigation project.
