School District Future Plans is to Consolidate Two Blueridge Elementary Schools

The North Vancouver School District is looking at replacing the two existing schools with a larger 475 capacity school in 6-9 years, which really makes little sense considering that the two current schools will be full with 251 students at Seymour Heights and 344 students at Blueridge Elementary = 595 students. How will already full schools cope with an extra 120 students in one mega-school?

From the attachment you will see that our local schools are expected to be very near or above full capacity for the next 10 years.
