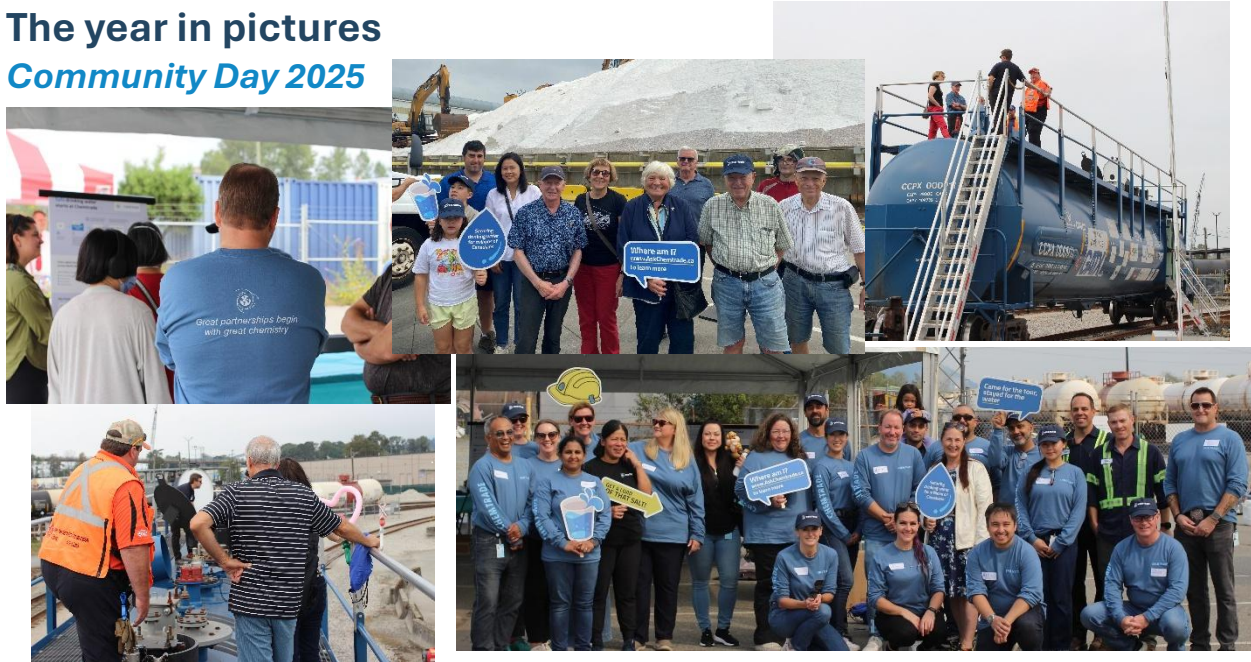
Looking back on the year, and ahead to 2026

The last year has been an exciting one for us at Chemtrade. We hosted our first Community Day, where we welcomed over 350 members of the community to our site. We supported several local initiatives – like the Blueridge Good Neighbour Day, the District of North Vancouver Fire Fighters Charitable Society Pumpkin Drop and Barn Burner, North Vancouver's Butterfly Way, and the Tsleil-Waututh Nation Whey-ah-Wichen Canoe Festival. We also hosted many tours of the facility, taking dozens of residents, along with members of the North Vancouver Chamber of Commerce, the North Vancouver Lion's Club, and members a local Parent Advisory Committee through the facility. We supported 118 local, well-paid jobs, and injected tens of millions of dollars into the local economy through wages and local spend with suppliers, contractors, and vendors.

Looking ahead to 2026, we look forward to more opportunities to connect with the community through continued public tours, and support for local initiatives. We will be hosting another Community Day in 2027 and will share more details as the event gets closer.
