RE: Public Consultation | Mt Seymour Resorts' 60-Year Ski Resort Development Plan

To Whom It May Concern,

We are writing to inform you that Mt Seymour Resorts Ltd. has begun the public consultation process for our Ski Resort Development Plan, taking place from May 26 to June 26. This plan outlines our vision for how the resort will gradually evolve over the next six decades to enhance the guest experience while operating responsibly within Mount Seymour Provincial Park.

Mt Seymour is adapting to Vancouver's ever-changing population and climate by accessing new intermediate terrain at higher elevations and offering year-round activities.

Mt Seymour Resorts has been part of the community for many decades. Since Harold Enquist first opened a small lodge, built ski runs, rope tows and a ski rental operation in 1938, the resort has grown alongside the Lower Mainland. Since 1984, our family has owned, managed, invested in, and improved the resort and is proud to be Vancouver's only remaining family-owned and operated ski area. Over the years, under its Park Use Permit, the resort has continuously sought to balance growth and innovation with a deep respect for the mountain, the Park, and the surrounding community, in line with its mandate from BC Parks to provide winter recreation.

The Ski Resort Development Plan builds on this legacy. It outlines opportunities to improve ski terrain and lifts, enhance guest services and base area facilities, expand learning areas, preserve public backcountry access, and introduce new year-round recreation opportunities. The goal is to



ensure that Mt Seymour continues to provide accessible, enjoyable, and memorable experiences for all visitors while evolving in a responsible and sustainable manner.
